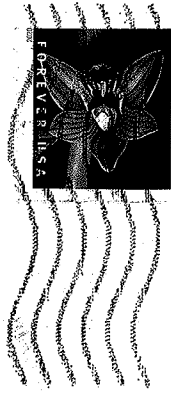

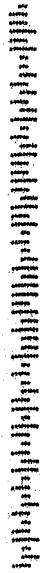


Dear Mt. Tamalpais Staff & Volunteers
