the only reason I am at virus-free SQ is that Derrius Jones (P.U.P.'s On-Site Program Coordinator) coached me, through the mail, on how

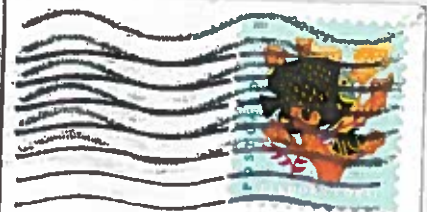
to get accepted to P.U.P. & transfer to S.Q. from virus-ravaged CIM (Chino). I left Chino just in time ... for now, CIM in-
